As the weather starts to change, and we dust off the clubs for our 1st rounds of the season, I want to get you up to date with all that is new for 2022. 
# <u>Square your Shoulders</u>



One of the biggest issues I find with golfers that are struggling with their swings is their shoulder alignment. Making sure that your get in a proper set-up before taking the club back is step 1 to getting your swing on the right track.

Open Shoulders with a square clubface = Pulled shots to the left Open Shoulders with an open clubface = Sliced shots to the right Closed Shoulders with a square clubface = Pushed shots to the right Closed Shoulders with a closed clubface = Hooked shots to the left

Make sure you square your club, shoulders, feet, and hips before taking the club back, and you will see more consistent results!
