#### WELCOME TO SPRIN/TER!

We want to welcome all our new members. We are kicking off the ladies' golf season, albeit a little late, on Thursday, May 4th, and every Thursday thereafter (our "ladies' day").

There will be a Meet and Greet on May 18th. Social hour will be 4:30 to 5:30 with appetizers and bar service. This is a great time to come meet the women from the club. Bridge, mahjong, golf, pool, and social members are all invited. We will have a short presentation at approximately 6 p.m. from a member of the women's board, Eric, and others detailing events happening at the club.

We will be mixing it up this year with different golf games on Thursdays at 11 a.m. Eric, our Pro, will be planning fun events at least once or twice a month, along with a little gambling (\$2 or \$3) for some competition. You need to sign in or call the pro shop to get your name on the signup sheet before 10:45. The groups are drawn at 10:45. This is a great way to meet the members. This group may also play a side skins game for \$2, but you do not have to play the side game if you choose not to. Let the pro shop know before you begin to play.

The golfers who do not have established handicaps are still welcome to play on Thursdays if the game does not require a handicap. Also, a 9-hole league one night during the week after work is being formed. Check with Eric or Nic in the golf shop to sign up and get more information. This will be an anything-goes format for those who would just like to play for fun. However, if you would like to establish a handicap, this is a great way to get started! No matter your level, we are excited to have you as members and would like to accommodate your golf desires. 



## Keep It Simple - Ball Position

Early in the season it is important to pay attention to the fundamentals. Proper ball position allows you to swing more freely, and make better contact. See the chart below for an example of where the ball should be in relation to your stance.



### Playing the ball too far back can cause these problems...

Shots move to the right because the club does not have time to square up

A reverse tilt in the downswing - resulting in poor contact that is often heavy

## Playing the ball too far forward can cause these problems...

Shot that move to the left because the club has over-rotated as it approaches impact A sway into the ball on the downswing resulting in poor contact this is often thin
