Put your boat building skills to the test and create a boat using cardboard and duct tape.


Then, name it, climb in and race it to the finish line!

FISHING AT OAKWOOD



As we enter the peak of the summer months, fishing activity at the Club has increased lately. In many cases, unfortunately, many of the young folks fishing are not members. In addition, when confronted, they mention member names and indicate those members have told them they are welcome to fish in our ponds. We have also had instances of tee markers theft and some vandalism.

Nothing major, but it has escalated recently. We wanted to take this opportunity to remind you of our rules about fishing and being on the course if not playing golf.

- Member fishing is NOT permitted between the hours of 7am and 7pm, Tuesday-Sunday and 12pm-7pm Monday (Mondays could differ depending on an event/holiday). Even though we have 7:00pm time posted in the evenings, please be aware of golfers who may still be on the course, especially in proximity to the two ponds.
- All members must contact the clubhouse/golf shop when having the intention of fishing.
- Members that do go fishing that do not live on/near property that drive to the club must park in Oakwood's parking lot and walk out to the ponds. Parking in the surrounding neighborhoods and walking through private properties is not permitted.
- Non-members (Guests) must always be accompanied by a member.
- Any individual fishing within the guidelines is at your own risk, Oakwood CC is not liable for any injury.
- Individuals that are not members caught fishing without a member present will be considered trespassing, and we will contact local authorities and/or the game warden to remove these individuals and take appropriate legal action for trespassing.




