

# Chipping Drill

This chipping drill will help you make more consistent contact leading to better chip shots.

- 1. Set-up and alignment stick 4 inches behind the ball on your target line
- 2. Focus on taking the club back along the alignment stick on the take-away
  - \*Too many golfers take the club back too far to the inside on the take-away which leads to the club exiting to the right of your target. It may also cause you to flip your hands through impact in an effort to square up the club\*
- 3. Make sure you finish your chip with your rotation
