We are honored to be able to host the IWGA Senior Women's Amateur this September. The tournament will be held September 18th through September 21st. With this being the last year the IWGA will host this tournament, we couldn't be more excited and honored for this historical event. Who is ready for a celebration? Oakwood Country Club was originally established in 1923 on the original land plot in Moline located under I-74. This year marks the 100-year anniversary of Oakwood Country Club. Join us on Saturday, October 7th and help us celebrate this historical achievement.

At the end of the month moving into October, we will continue our work on replacing the pergolas outside of the golf bar. This will ensure them to be structurally sound for years to come. Please be aware that outdoor dining may be affected from time to time by the construction.

As most of you are aware, the State of Illinois pool inspector was on site the morning of August 22nd, and based on their evaluation of certain mechanical issues, ordered that the pool be closed immediately, drained and power washed before refilling. We began the process immediately with the intention of re-opening before the Holiday weekend, but please understand it could take at least 5 days to drain/power wash and fill. It will be several days after refill before temperatures are at a more comfortable level. We sincerely apologize for this inconvenience.

Thank you to Doug Jacquin, Erickson Plumbing and Kale Heating and Air Conditioning for helping us put together all the required information to replace the club's boiler system and a potential Mid-American rebate. This capital improvement will not only save the club a significant amount of money right away in gas bills, but it will also provide a more sustainable temperature-controlled environment during the cooler seasons.

We have already forecasted some work to be tackled during the annual shutdown in mid-January. Besides some deep cleaning of the carpets and clubhouse, we continue to work on expanding the pool deck to the building, installing changing stalls in the men's restroom at the pool and work on the showers in the lady's locker room. I welcome any suggestions to assist with clubhouse remodel and refurbish.

IWGA 54th Illinois Senior Women's Amateur Championship Comes to Oakwood

Oakwood Country Club will Host the Illinois State Senior Women's Amateur Golf Tournament September 19th, 2023 through September 21st, 2023. A field of 88 Senior Women will light up the course with "Great Golf" and "Revisiting Friendships" from over the years of the IWGA.

Oakwood Country Club is looking forward to "Hosting" this prestigious Ladies Golf event for the "Third" time. We previously hosted the tournament in 2003 and 2011. In 2003, Oakwood crowned one of our own, Rosalie Barnet, winning in a one-hole Playoff, blasting out of the bunker on Hole #1 to defeat Sally Wessels of Rockford, II. Member, Donna Edwards, also won Low Net for the 2003 tournament at Oakwood

In 2013, another of our members, Laurie Redden won Low Net in 2013 at The Den Golf Course, in Bloomington, Illinois. Also, over the years we have had many Ladies of Oakwood win Flight events at the tournaments.

Eligibility for the Illinois Senior Amateur Golf Tournament consists of the following: 1) Amateur Women Golfers who have reached their 50th Birthday by the first day of play, and have a current USGA Handicap Index less than 30.

2) A minimum of three, 18- hole scores from the current calendar year, must be posted by the entry deadline.

The Championship will be determined by:

1) 54 holes of Stroke play

2) Players will be flighted by age group, with flights to be determined after the close of registration

3) "Champion" will be the low gross winner across the entire field. If ties, the overall Champion will be determined by a sudden-death playoff.
